In February 1798. as part of the preparations for defending England from Napoleon, a survey was undertaken in Buckinghamshire of the names and occupations of all the men between the ages of 15 and 60 years, in each of the hundreds of the County. Of the 92 people named in Swanbourne, 14 were farmers, 4 butchers, 12 baker, 3 carpenters, 2 wheelwrights, 3 blacksmiths, 1 shop keeper, 2 gardeners, 6 cordwainers. 3 taylors, 1 tinker, 1 chimneysweep, 13 servants, 37 labourers and 1 constable.
