1907 to Canada	The passenger list for 1907 shows Alfred, age 21, single and a farm labourer leaving Glasgow, Scotland on the Mongolian. He arrives in Halifax, Nova Scotia on 23 rd April 1907 and his destination is Sherbrooke, Quebec, Canada.
1910 return to Canada	After returning to England (just for a visit) Alfred travelled to Canada for the second time, age 24, departing from Liverpool and arriving in Halifax, Nova Scotia on 8 th Apr 1910 on the Virginian. Also on the same journey is Arthur Sidney Gurnett. Alfred declares he has been to Canada before, resident in Port Hope, Ontario
1911 Canadian Census info	Alfred cannot be found in the Canadian Census (taken 1 st June 1911) although he is probably at 134, Market Street, Brantford, Ontario. His family in England still live in Nearnton End, Swanbourne, Alfred (59, farm labourer), Emma (60, m 38 years, had 8 children), Edith (22), Annie (20) and grandson Charley Boughton (14).
1912 back to England to marry	Both Alfred Alderman and Arthur Gurnett return to England to marry. They arrive on 30 th Mar 1912, travelling on the Empress of Ireland.
1912 details of marriage	12 th June, 1912 at St Georges, Tufnell Park, Islington, Middx. Banns were read in Swanbourne. At marriage Alfred is 26, a labourer, resident at Nearnton End, Swanbourne (his parents address) and Ethel is 22, resident at 227, Junction Road, Upper Holloway.
