Thomas Fremantle was the 3 rd of 4 sons (John, Stephen, Thomas and William) and 3 daughters born to John Fremantle of Aston Abbots. His mother, Frances Edwards, daughter of John Edwards of Bristol was an heiress, and probably the source of the family' wealth, which enabled them to rise up in society.		Elizabeth (Betsey) Wynne was the 2 nd of 5 daughters born to Richard Wynne of Folkingham, Lincs and his French wife, Camille de Royer. Richard Wynne had been born in Venice, and later sold up his Lincolnshire estate, and travelled the continent with his family. It was then that Betsey started her famous diaries.
